

## **CCSL Minimum Standards for Regional Clubs:**

In an effort to improve the system of development for our youth players on the Central Coast it is important to have a strong CCSL playing league.

Minimum Standards act as quality assurance and goal setting for our regional clubs. Though we know that each club will be run slightly different than the next, based on geographical, philosophical or economic differences, we feel that the below written Minimum Standards can and should be upheld by all.

### 1. Minimum **Regional Central Coast** \_ BOD Requirements:

- President
- Vice President
- Secretary (Records minutes of the Club)
- Treasurer (Manages monies of the Club)
- Registrar (Registers players to Cal South)
- Director of Coaching Implements Development Programs for coaches and players of the club; Attends CCSL DOC Meetings to collaborate with other DOCs and the CCSL DOC)
- Recreational/CCSL Liaison (Attends meetings of CCSL and Rec leagues)

Who votes and who doesn't vote is decided by the individual regional clubs Board of Directors, governed by their bylaws, rules and regulations, and/or constitution.

2. Well publicized and open **Regional Central Coast** \_ try-outs for the upcoming season. This takes proper planning, coach selection and local promotion by the regional club. Our goals should be to identify and encourage as many youth players locally to attend regional try-outs.

### 3. **Regional Central Coast Minimum Team Development Requirements:**

Every Season - have a U10 team for boys and a U10 team for girls and **provide the opportunity to** all age groups to the area through open tryouts, with final # of teams made according to viable players attending tryouts. Coaches for each age group should be sought out by the DOC early on to ensure a coach is in place if there are enough committed players to man a team.

4. Representative (President/ VP/CCSL Liaison) from each CCSL regional club to attend monthly CCSL meeting on behalf of their club, to report club news and meet.
5. DOC regular meetings: Representative (DOCs) from each CCSL regional club to attend (four times yearly) DOC Meetings put on by and for the development of the CCSL and our regional clubs DOC's.
6. Encourage all coaches/team representatives attend the AGM (April), Season Kickoff (August or September), and Voting Meetings (November).
7. Assist the league by **requiring** all teams in your **Regional Central Coast** club to abide by Cal South and CCSL rules and regulations and to uphold all registration deadlines set by both.
8. Keep the league informed of all changes in your **Regional Central Coast** club/teams that may affect League business. (I.e. field issues, coach changes, disciplinary issues, etc.)
9. All **Regional Central Coast** Coaches must be licensed with a minimum 'E' as required by Cal South and it is strongly recommended that U15 and up coaches attain the 'D' license. Eventually this will be a minimum requirement for Cal South
10. All **Regional Central Coast** Clubs work with pre -2008, existing teams to a compromise that will help unify the Region and give every player equal opportunity to develop, be identified and be promoted.
