## 7. DISCUSSION ON REGIONAL CONCEPTS

- a. Orlando Sabi- Ganas: Independent Team wants opportunity to Unify. North County not ready. Need someone to unify coaches to work with the kids. One trainer can't do it. There are other options. Charging high prices for everything is gouging people. Feels DOC telling them that if they pay lots money, their kids will play at CalPoly – feels it's misleading.
- Alicia P: What do you need? DOC is elected by BOD of that region. CCSL can't step into each region's issues.
- O.S. feels current BOD is not experienced enough or familiar with area. He does not support regional concept as it stands.
- A.P. CCSL requires minimum standards : each region must have a DOC.
- Greg: Regional idea requires patience. CCSL drew a line that may have been premature. Possible CCSL should support/promote clubs trying to get going.
- A.P. If don't draw that line in sand prevents – several teams new ones from joining.
- Culture: Based on experience
- Paul H.: Encouraged taking steps forward. Discouraged that people, parents, BOD can't develop infrastructure for kids. Lots good local soccer clubs, organized, stable, with DOC. Regionalization will resolve if can work past the roadblocks.
- Greg: Lots of work being done, not smooth and quick.
- Regionalization is not that easy. Major organizational growing pains.
- A.P. Can't happen overnight;
- RVR: He doesn't recognize any of our political lines; from Torrance and involved in clubs there. Seen what happens in each age level. Totally behind that.. Doesn't know who will be coaching, etc.
- M. Tamaki: Very encouraged as to how far we've come so far. Turnout tonight shows the energy. New organization helped people review and develop new teams/organization. Tremendous merit to CCSL for progress to date.
- P.H.: Recognizes how hard everyone has worked. Keep working together to forge the partnerships and collaborate. Goal to get the kids on the soccer field at any level.
- Tammy S: Concept required too short a deadline. Clubs forced to put BOD together via ultimatum – right now; not given 2 or 3 years.
- P.H.: Have been trying that for 20 yrs. Sometimes you have to force them to get together otherwise we all tend to procrastinate!
- A.P. CCSL had to take strong stance to get the change rolling.
- Tammy S: Existing clubs need more time.
- Matt (No. Co): What was started doesn't necessarily fit with existing teams. NoCo Board came out of AYSO; Power/politics forcing issues. Trying hard to work through issues within NoCo.
- Sam Mc: Lots people sitting back to see what's going to happen. Young BOD but don't know what to expect; May not happen. CCSL is dictating expectations for this league, not working with groups.

Carrie: 3 Madrid teams in NoCo. An established Club. Now lots other politics involved via NCFC. Please, just leave their teams alone.

**Regionalization v. Independent Teams (no league registry)**

- 1) Policy to not allow independent teams this year: Should we hold off on this?
- 2) CCSL minimum standards necessary for development plan and DOC plus long range
- 3) 5 Regional clubs that new teams must join CCSL
- 4) 17 Independent teams in CCSL
- 5) 14 are in NoCo (CYSA requires min. 5 teams to be registered as league of registry in CYSA)

A.P. Read to room Minimum Standards Policy per BOD

**MOTION 1 (J. Camacho): Move to postpone requirement for each club to develop Bu10/Gu10 team for a period of one year.** 2<sup>nd</sup> Sam McMillan

Discussion 1:

Matt: Every club must make a strong effort to develop a U10.

Mark J: Agree may be difficulty due to fragmentation. DOC is key as well as education for coaches. Resistance to change keeps us further away from vision promotion development and education.

Cindy: Would like to amend motion to obtain at least one U10 per regional club.(No 2<sup>nd</sup>)

M. Stroub: Let them try; not easy and need buffer.

James: If U10 teams not obtainable? Throw away U11's? Ans: NO

Vote 1: In Favor of Postponing requirement that each CCSL Existing Team develop a U10 G/B for a period of 1 year = 12 For vs. 3 Against

Greg: Minimum Standards doesn't say: Request clarification of Item 10. Clubs should try to work with existing teams that are Independent.

James: If two clubs who chooses? Can we go forward without regionalization?

**MOTION 2 (D.Arnold): Motion to postpone regionalization for a period of one year.** 2<sup>nd</sup> O.Sabi.

Discussion:

D.A.: Problem is 4 regions not set yet. Difference is that we're all here for more positive communication to work toward regionalization in one year. Allow establish foundation.

M. Jones: Problem many don't understand the basic concept and the benefits. Improvement is made, but must spread the right message.

James: Chang of soccer culture required; son played AYSO. Understood it at the beginning; people afraid always move away from change. BOD sold it without self doubt;lots bought in. Waiver is bad way to lead.

Seth: NoCo is working toward regionalization (not forced regionalization) but it will take time.

Vote 2: In Favor of Postponing Requirement to Regionalize for 1 year = 12 For, vs. Against = 9

CCSL: Will register existing teams. New independent teams require at least 5 teams to become league of registration.
