1) Call to Order **Start: 7:18 pm**

2) Introductions

3) Nominations/Elections

Discussion: Several primary club contacts failed to distribute the e-mail to their teams that was sent from the CCSL Secretary that announced and requested nominations for open positions in CCSL for 2009 Season CCSL. This appeared to be widespread. Attendees want chance to return to their teams and find persons to fill these positions.

Vote to take place via e-mail with one vote per team submitted to Parliamentarian, Cherie Moore and CCSL Secretary. Results then posted on web.

- President passed out a survey to all in attendance for feedback & constructive criticism

 - ii. Cumulative points issue depended in some cases on this resolution

Discussion:

2) Regionalization: CCSL can not be a league of registration. Individual teams will not be able to register without forming clubs with registrar.
